

Strict-Transport-Security Header Not Set

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Microsoft IIS webserver

- Start the application named: IIS Manager.
- Select your website
- On the right part of the screen, access the option named: HTTP Response Headers.
- On the top right part of the screen, click on the Add option.
- To enable the HSTS feature, enter the following configuration:
 - NAME: Strict-Transport-Security
 - VALUE: max-age=31536000; includeSubDomains; preload

Click on the OK button.

Nginx webserver

In your nginx.conf file add:

```
add-header Strict-Transport-Security "max-age=31536000; includeSubDomains; preload";
```

Apache webserver

Make sure that the headers module is loaded: **sudo a2enmod headers**

Add the following code to the apache2.conf file:

```
<IfModule mod_headers.c>  
    Header always set Strict-Transport-Security "max-age=31536000; includeSubDomains;  
    preload"  
</IfModule>
```
