

X-Content-Type-Options Header Missing

Microsoft IIS webserver

- Start the application named: IIS Manager.
- Select your website
- On the right part of the screen, access the option named: HTTP Response Headers.
- On the top right part of the screen, click on the Add option.
- To enable the X-Content-Type-Options header, enter the following configuration:
 - NAME: X-Content-Type-Options
 - VALUE: nosniff

Click on the OK button.

Nginx webserver

In your nginx.conf file add:

```
add-header X-Content-Type-Options "nosniff";
```

Apache webserver

Make sure that the headers module is loaded: **sudo a2enmod headers**

Add the following code to the apache2.conf file:

```
<IfModule mod_headers.c>  
    Header always set X-Content-Type-Options "nosniff"  
</IfModule>
```
